## Embry-Riddle Prescott is accepting student travel grant applications for its April 16-17, 2025 event.

Each travel grant is designed to partially cover travel expenses such as airline tickets and hotel stays. Grant amounts are as follows:

- \$500 for students within the state of Arizona
- \$1,000 for students outside of Arizona

In order to apply, **students must be enrolled in a U.S. institution.** Preference is given to students who are working on cybersecurity topics and can present a **cybersecurity research poster**, show evidence of financial need to attend the workshop, and commit to participate in the **capture-the-flag competition**.
