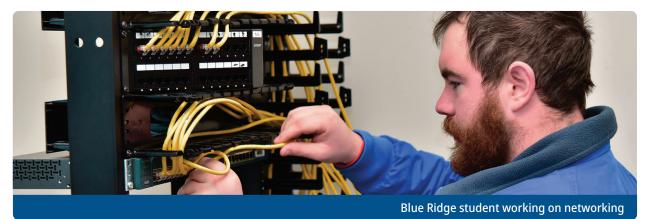


BLUE RIDGE COMMUNITY COLLEGE
