They are trained to install and configure network devices, end-user workstations/devices, and virtualized network servers that control, monitor, or provide user services on internal or external networks. CNST is designated as a NSA/DHS National Center of Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense Two-Year Education (CAE-2Y) [2018-2023].
