Opportunity for faculty to lecture and/or conduct research for up to a year abroad

Fulbright U.S. Specialist Program

Opportunity for faculty to serve as expert consultants in curriculum, faculty development, institutional planning at academic institutions abroad for a period of 2 to 6 weeks

Benefits

Typical award stipend varies by country (e.g. in 2020, the stipend in Finland is 5,000 euros per month)

Travel allowance to cover airfare and baggage costs may or may not be included (e.g. in Finland, travel allowance is \$1,800)

Depending on the award, dependents may accompany the awardee, who may receive additional subsistence allowance

Host institution helps the awardee find suitable housing for the awardee

Open avenues for collaborations in research and curriculum development

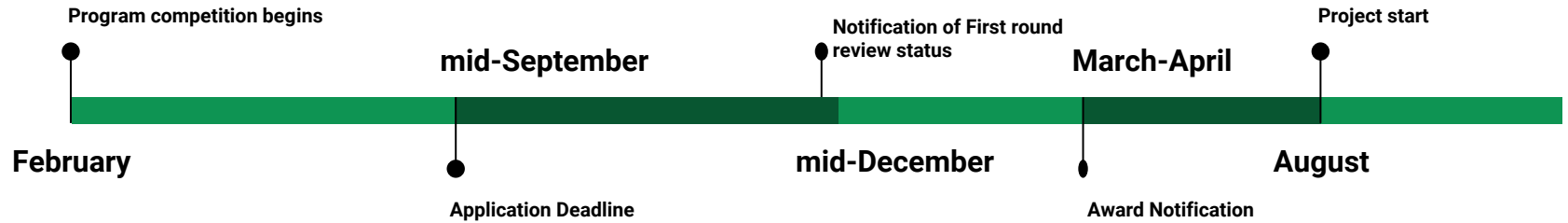
