Stony Brook's Department of Computer Science is experiencing significant growth, with research expenditures growing by 25% and the number of faculty growing by 15% in the last three years. It is ranked #13 in computer security and #23 overall, according to CSrankings.org.

As the largest producer of undergraduate and doctoral degrees in computer science in New York, we are committed to expanding computing education and have made great strides in outreach to underrepresented students. With a strong trajectory of growth and excellence, the Department of Computer Science continues to push the boundaries of research and education.

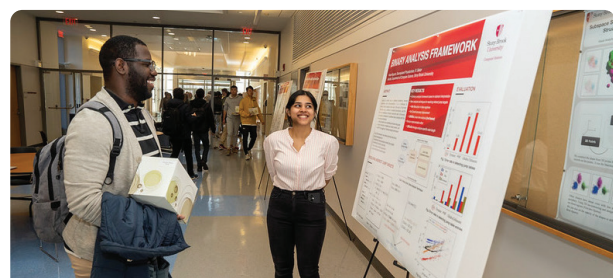
