- Established Center for Cybersecurity must have all the required and up to date contents and must be hosted as part of the institution's domain

## New CAE-C POC Onboarding Process Useful Suggestions



#### Make sure that you are aware of and have access to the

- The "Center" Website (URL) is visible within the institution and the external community at large
- "Center" POC is noted
- Information about and link to the program page of the Validated PoS(s)
- Faculty members
- Links to student cybersecurity activities available to students at the institution and beyond
- News that include both internal and external cybersecurity news. Internal news should highlight cybersecurity activities and efforts at the institution and/or other cybersecurity activities of students and faculty representing the institution. External cybersecurity news should highlight upto-date trending cybersecurity information
- Link to the institutional security resources and awareness
- Up-to-date links to key cybersecurity resources for students such as cyber competitions
- Documentation on the Industry Advisory Board/Committee


