#### Defining

Cyber sexual assault is a term used to describe a range of harmful, sexually exploitative behaviors that occur through digital technologies. It encompasses any form of sexual violence or harassment that is carried out using electronic means or online platforms, often causing emotional, psychological, or reputational harm to the victim.





#### Types

- Non-consensual Sharing of Intimate Images (Revenge Porn)
- Online Sexual Harassment or Cyberstalking
- Cyberbullying with a Sexual Element
- Hacking or Exploiting Connected Sexual Devices
- Deepfake Pornography (including AI generated Child Pornography)
- Sextortion
- Virtual Sexual Assault (via Online Games or Platforms)
