

Share the Spark: Advancing the Development of New and Early-Career Faculty in the CAE Community

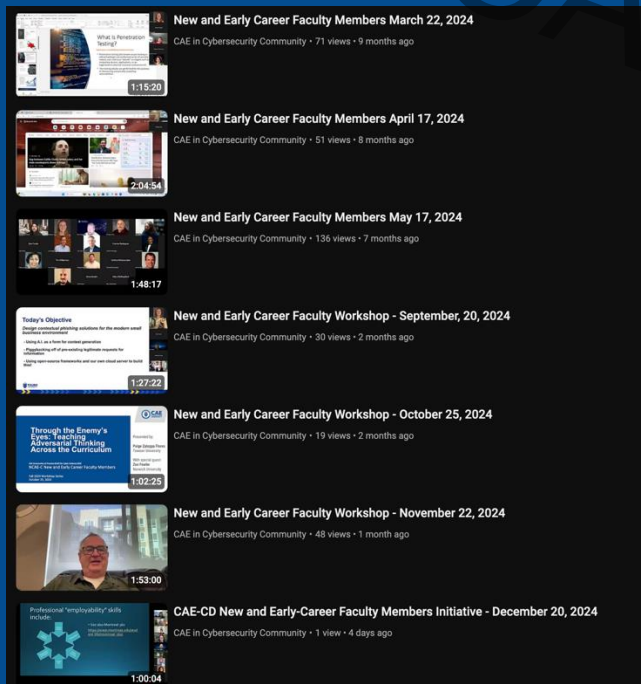
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Goals
