






What is Rural anyway?

According to the current delineation, released in 2022 and based on the 2020 decennial census, rural areas comprise open country and settlements with fewer than 2,000 housing units and 5,000 residents. Urban areas comprise densely developed areas with 2,000 or more housing units or 5,000 or more residents. Jan 8, 2025




About 97% of the United States' land is rural, but only about 20% of the population lives in rural areas.
